

# First-Year Application Instructions

*UConn considers all first-year applicants for Honors and merit scholarship eligibility upon initial review; there is not a separate application or supplement for Honors or scholarship consideration. Due to the number of applications received, interviews are not part of the admissions process.*

**A Completed Application**

\* First-year applicants must apply online through either the **Common Application** or **apply Coalition on Scoir**.

**Personal Essay**

**Two Optional Letters of Recommendation**

\* Two letters of recommendation are optional, but can distinguish an applicant's character.

**\$80 Application Fee (non-refundable)**

\* Submit your \$80 application fee through your chosen application.

**Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR) or High School Transcript**

**Standardized Test (Optional)**

\* **Institutional Codes: SAT – 3915; ACT - 0604**
